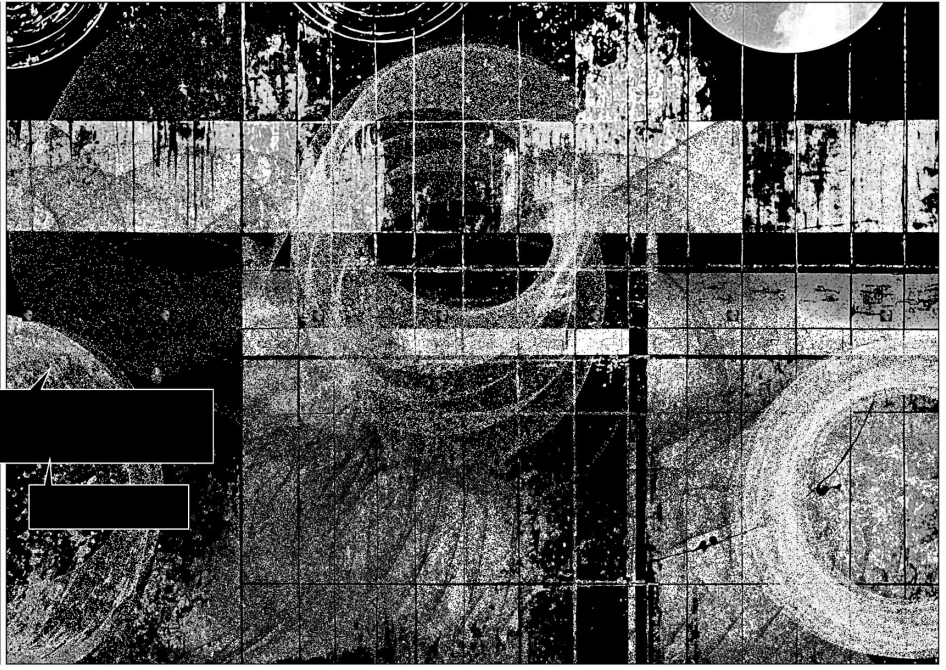

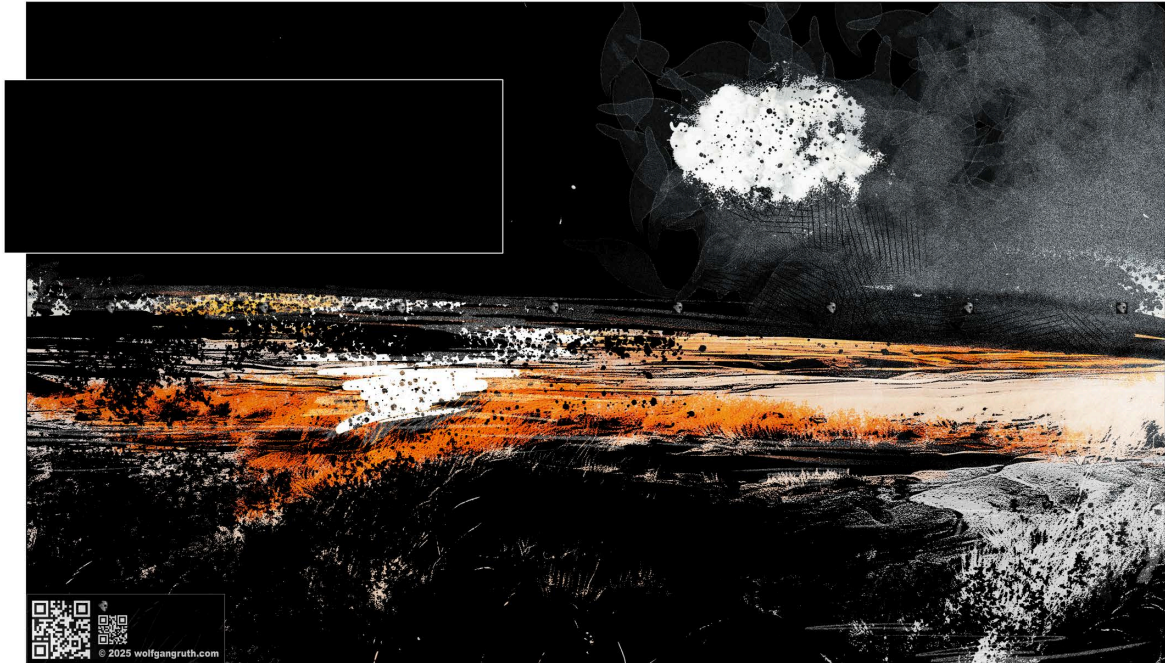

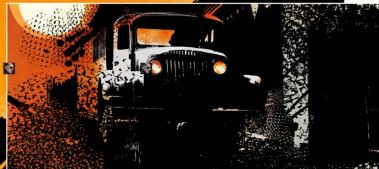
This is true liberty, when free-born men,
